NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

The District of Columbia Taxicab Commission (Commission), pursuant to the authority set forth in section 8(c)(14) of the District of Columbia Taxicab Commission Establishment Act of 1985, effective March 25, 1986 (D.C. Law 6-97; D.C. Official Code §§ 50-306 (2009 Repl.; 2012 Fall Supp.)) as amended by Section 20m of the Taxicab Service Improvement Amendment Act of 2012, effective October 22, 2012 (D.C. Law 19-59 DCR 9431) hereby gives notice of its intent to adopt amendments to Chapter 5 (Taxicab Companies, Associations, and Fleets and Independent Taxicabs), of Title 31 (Taxicabs and Public Vehicles for Hire) of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR).

The proposed amendment clarifies that all enforcement actions shall be governed by Chapter 7 of this Title.

The Commission also hereby gives notice of the intent to take final rulemaking action to adopt these proposed rules in not less than thirty (30) days after the publication of this notice in the *D.C. Register*.

Chapter 5, TAXICABS COMPANIES, ASSOCIATIONS, AND FLEETS AND INDEPENDENT TAXICABS, is amended as follows:

Subsection 500, APPLICATION AND SCOPE, is amended to read:

500.3 The enforcement of this Chapter shall be governed by the procedures set forth in Chapter 7 of this Title.

Subsection 510.3 is DELETED.

Subsections 518.2 and 518.3 are DELETED.
