The **15th Annual Safeway Feast of Sharing** will be held **Wednesday, November 26, 2014**. A traditional Thanksgiving meal will be served from 11:30 AM to 2:00 PM. This year's goal is to serve 5,000 people. 700 volunteers are needed for Feast of Sharing activities throughout the entire day.

This event, sponsored by Safeway, Events DC, SunTrust, CenterPlate, Metropolitan Baptist Church, Unity Health Care, The Salvation Army, Digital Conventions, and The Mid-Atlantic Gleaning Network, features a plated Thanksgiving dinner, a Job Fair, health screenings, and free winter clothing for DC area residents in need.

On November 26th, starting at 9am, volunteers report to room 202, to sign in, receive their assignment and commemorative apron. Community Service certificates provided after the event.

#### **VOLUNTEER ASSIGNMENTS:**

**Greeter (Needed at 8:30am!)** – Provides a warm *Hello* to guests as they arrive in the building.

**Host/ Hostess** – Greets & Seats the guests as they arrive in the dining hall area.

**Table server** – Take filled plates of food from the dish-up stations to the persons seated at the tables.

**Gleaning Support** – Assist with bagging and distributing donated fruits and vegetables.

**Volunteer Registration Assistant (Needed at 8am!)** – The check-in point for all volunteers by insuring all stations have the required volunteers at all times, and issuing volunteer aprons.

**Clean-up Assistant** - Assists in cleaning up of the hall after the event- includes aiding in the disbursement of remaining food, clearing tables, and cleaning of assigned rooms.

**First-Aid Area Assistant** – For those with nursing or CPR experience at the First Aid Station.

**\*IMPORTANT NOTE:** volunteers may be assigned to areas where assistance is most needed.
